- Creating of the Art Exhibition "Nature - Muse of Inspiration"
- Familiarizing visitors with the tendencies of contemporary art
- Exchanging experiences and developing international cooperations in the sphere of organizations, implementation of plein aires, symposia and other forms of "creative holidays" in rural localities

PLACE:

The surrounding area attracts many visitors with its unique history, Spiš Gothic, various museums, as well as the magnificent High Tatras mountain range and protected National parks of Tatra and Slovak Paradise with many waterfalls, karst phenomena, and underground caves.

CONDITIONS:

- Accommodation and meals, materials for creation - canvas (max. 3pcs / person), colors, clay (max 50kg / person), glazes and ceramic burning are at disposal.
- Each participant may be painting or work with ceramics, or use both techniques.
- The artist gifts 1-2 works (according to the size and type of the work) made during the artistic symposium, based on the organizer's choice, and grants the right for the issue of a publication, for publishing and imprinting of their work by the organizer according to an approved project.
- Transport is covered by each participant himself.

SYMPOSIUM OUTPUT:

- The opening of the Art Symposium will take place on 21 June 2018 during the jubilee conference of the Slovak Paradise National Park in the Cultural Center "Reduta".
- Some artworks will be included in the overall exhibition of the "Areas of Inspiration" project and exhibited in 2019 in three cities in Eastern Europe. In addition, a work catalog will be issued.
- If desired by the artist, organizers can help with the sale of his works at exhibitions and with the return of the artist's works after completion of the project.
- At his discretion, the artist can additionally exhibit his work in the organizer's exhibitions and insure them.
